Appellation Napa Valley

Sites This year's blend is 95% from Diamond Mountain and 5% from Oakville.

Soil Napa Valley soils are primarily comprised of broken down or decomposed rock

that has been carried downhill from the eastern Vaca range and the western

Mayacamas range into the base of the valley where they ultimately intermingle with

the silt, clay and gravel deposits of the Napa River flood plain.

VINTAGE

Growing Season 2008 had a warmer vintage which optimized maturity throughout the growing

season. As a result, this vintage produced reds with chewier tannins and is

recognized as a great vintage for the Napa Valley.
