VINEYARD

Site Westside Farms, our 75 acre ranch on Westside Road, has been in use as farmland

since the middle 1800s.

Soil The soil here is Yolo silty loam, derived from sedimentary formation in alluvial fans.

Clone This vintage was sourced from Block 4, which is planted to Clone 4.

Planted Block 4 was planted in 2006 with twelve by eight foot spacing.

VINTAGE

Growing Season Winter 2015 was the warmest on record, resulting in early budbreak. Cooler, wetter

weather in spring months slowed development, however, leading to a challenging, extended bloom period. The resulting uneven fruit set translated to a small crop and smaller berries with very concentrated flavors. The exceptionally early budbreak led

to an equally early harvest.

WINEMAKING

Varietal Compositon 100% Chardonnay

Fermentation We whole-cluster press for phenolic delicacy. Native-yeast and full native malolactic

fermentations take place in barrel, with sur lies bâtonnage.

Aging After aging 18 months in 20% new François Frères barrels, this Chardonnay was

lightly fined and settled in tank before being bottled without filtration.
