**Appellation** Russian River Valley

**Site** Ritchie Vineyard is widely spaced, as was the fashion in the early '70s. These

old vines with their gnarly trunks produce small clusters with distinct "hen

and chick" character.

**Soil** The benchland soil is gravelly, sandy Goldridge Loam, originating from the

bed of an ancient inland sea, over volcanic Tufa rock

**Planted** Our block was planted in 1972

**Growing Season** The 2009 vintage came close to ideal, with steady, moderate temperatures

throughout the growing season, no desiccating heat spikes and no rain until

all the Chardonnay had been picked.

**Fermentation** Whole-cluster pressing for delicacy, native-yeast fermentation and full,

natural malolactic fermentation in barrel

**Aging** 19 months in 52% new French oak barrels and aged *sur lies* with monthly

bâtonnage. Non-filtered
