

VINEYARD Site Westside Farms, our 75-acre ranch on Westside Road, has been in use as farmland since the middle 1800s. Soil The soil here is Yolo silty loam, derived from sedimentary formation in alluvial fans. Clone This vintage was sourced from Block 1, which is planted to a Spring Mountain selection. Planted Block 1 was planted in 1990 on AxR1 rootstock with fourteen by eight foot spacing. VINTAGE **Growing Season** 2017 began with a very wet winter. The summer was mild until a significant heatwave around Labor Day. Afterward, temperatures were warm and steady, allowing winemakers to make picking decisions based on optimal fruit maturity rather than impending weather. Yields were average to light. Fruit quality ranged from great to exceptional, with well-preserved acids.
