Growing Season The 2018 season was exemplary. Spring was drier than in 2017, and after two

years of poor set, consistently mild weather led to good berry set. Higher cluster counts than the low yielding years of 2015-2017, coupled with cooler late summer temperatures, brought longer hang times with harvest dates up

to two weeks later than the previous vintage.

WINEMAKING

Varietal Composition 100% Chardonnay

Fermentation We whole-cluster press for phenolic delicacy. Native yeast and full native

malolactic fermentations take place in barrel, with sur lies bâtonnage.

Aging After aging 20 months in 25% new François Frères and Taransaud Beaune

barrels, the Chardonnay was traditionally fined for clarity and texture and

bottled without filtration.
